

Important information for Bexley GPs and practice managers

New arrangements for Long Term Conditions Services to start from 13 Jan 2014

Following recent agreement with Bexley Clinical Commissioning Group, the new community teams linked to groups of GP practices and specialist long term conditions teams will be in place from **13th January 2014**.

The community teams will cover district nursing, virtual ward and podiatry services and will include a Community Forum Lead whose role it will be to establish better communication with groups of GP practices. They will also ensure there is a link nurse for each practice and practice multidisciplinary meetings are attended.
