Older Adults Intake Team

This team will provide a single point of access to the older adults' service. They will ensure that new referrals are promptly assessed and you are appropriately placed for treatment eg remain in the Intake Team or move to the Community Mental Health Team, Memory Service, Day Hospital or Inpatient care.

If it is decided that you do not need our services, the Intake Team will refer you back to your GP and advise them on how they can help you.
