Services that have been suspended	
Community nursing	District Nursing will continue to accept new referrals at this time. All referrals and visits will be clinically prioritised.
Continence	The continence service is accepting new referrals for the provision of incontinence pads for those who are unable to obtain their own.
Dietetics	Greenwich only - Supporting hospital discharges and on-going reviews for enteral feeding and support for malnourished patients. Bexley service is provided by Bromley Health.
HIV	Symptomatic screening will continue.
Home oxygen services	Respiratory will only be accepting urgent new referrals at this time. Patients known to the service will continue to be supported.
Intermediate bed based care	Meadow View will continue to accept referrals. Eltham Community Hospital is being repurposed to support stroke patients from Bexley Greenwich and Lewisham.
MSK	MSK is accepting urgent referrals only. All other clinics stopped.
Neuro-rehabilitation services	Neuro Rehab will only be accepting urgent new referrals at this time. Patients on the waiting list /caseload will be monitored via telephone and will not be offered appointments until further notice
OT	Urgent new referrals accepted including urgent equipment and EOL care.
Physiotherapy	Adult Physiotherapy (CART) will accept urgent new referrals.
Podiatry	At this time Podiatry will only be accepting referrals for high risk diabetic foot/active ulcers.
Rapid response	Rapid Response will continue to accept referral for urgent admission avoidance
Sexual health & contraception	The service will continue to provide emergency contraception, IUCD and coil fitting, Symptomatic STI screening and treatment, assessment of emergency symptoms, LARC complications, Pregnant women with STI reviewed, Completion of Hep B vaccines already started, Sexual assault care and under 18s.
Specialist nurses for specific conditions (plus, see OOH pathways)	The Tissue Viability Team will only be accepting urgent referrals for complex wound management and active ulcers at this time -The Lymphoedema service has been suspended until further notice.
Speech & Language Therapy	Adult Speech and Language will only be accepting urgent new referrals for swallowing problems at this time. Patients on the waiting list will not be offered appointments until further notice
EoL/Palliative Care	DISTRICT NURSING WILL CONTINUE TO ACCEPT NEW REFERRALS AT THIS TIME FOR END OF LIFE
Diabetes	Diabetes will accept urgent referrals. The diabetes advice line will remain open.
Heart failure	Cardiac and Heart Failure continue to accept urgent referrals. Patients on the caseload will be monitored via telephone and provided home exercises.
Respiratory/COPD	Respiratory will only be accepting urgent new referrals at this time. Patients known to the service will continue to be supported.
