


The National Quality Board (NQB) document "How to ensure the right people, with the right skills, are in the right place at the right time" (November 2013) set out expectations for providers of NHS services. Expectation 7 includes the requirement for boards to receive monthly updates on workforce information, including the number of actual staff on duty compared to the planned staffing level (day and night and registered and care staff), reasons for any gaps and actions taken to address these and impact on key quality and outcome measures. A more detailed Board Report is required 6 monthly and this will be included in Q1 and Q3 reporting.


In February NHS England released safer staffing performance of all NHS Trusts across the country. Measures included staff sickness, mandatory training, PDR, staff and patients views from the last national surveys. November utilisation data was used and Oxleas were rated " as expected". Contact time will also be included in future performance measures and Trusts will be required to capture this twice yearly.

The safer staffing group compared January utilisation of annual leave, study leave and sickness. Some areas are above the thresholds for utilisation i.e. the tarn had 38% Annual leave utilisation this may have contributed to their usage of substantive staff. The safer staffing group is triangulating this data with evidence from incidents.

In January AMH services reviewed all of their roster templates; staffing levels following a 6 month retrospective exercise of planned V actual utilisation have been adjusted. Clinical areas are now RAG rated for the directorate and this will be the
